Unitarian Universalists in Missouri have had no way to unite state-wide to address shared concerns. The Missouri Unitarian Universalist Advocacy Network is now helping.

MUUAN will model itself on networks and legislative ministries supported by the UUSC in other states.

The top priority is to make information about state-wide issues and efforts in congregations more accessible. For instance, if UUs in Springfield are interested in the midwifery issue, they will be able to go to MUUAN to find background information, analysis of legislation and contacts with UUs across the state who are involved in the issue.

MUUAN will identify an annual issue that UUs recognize as a major priority: affordable health care, fair taxes, anti-bullying legislation, and so on.
